Do you have water rights and wonder how the current river administration (call) may impact your rights this year? You are in luck because Colorado Northwestern Community College is hosting a one-day water rights workshop in Rangely on April 22, 2023 from 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 a.m.

The workshop will be presented by Aaron Clay who is a retired attorney at law and former 26-year Water Referee for Colorado Court, Division 4. Aaron is a great presenter and is extremely knowledgeable on water rights.

Most water right holders have a basic understanding of water rights but as the saying goes, the devil is in the details. Aaron has presented several times in Rio Blanco County and all attendees have expressed

their appreciation for his ability to present such a complicated topic in a manner that the average person can understand. Within the 8-hour workshop, you will understand the basics of Colorado Water Law and get answers to some of your more complicated questions.
